Willmotts Pool was the venue for Newtown A.C. where the carp were a bit slow to show to show and difficult to net as many got away. Thirteen members fished an amassed a total of 68lbs 15ozs. Leading the way was Terry Smith with20lbs 11ozs and in second spot was Roger saunders with 19lbs 10ozs and completing the top three was Paul Holland with 13lbs 5ozs.

Reading Fishing Club fished their match on Longwater Lake where they found the water levels very high. 13lbs was enough to win the match with 10lbs 10ozs in second spot and 10lbs 2ozs taking third spot. It was mainly bream with one carp of 5lbs and very few roach with a total weight of 52lbs.
